Are all agencies required to use this new tool?	The HIVQM Module is voluntary. Your organization may choose to use the HIVQM Module.
When will this take effect?	The HIVQM Module is in its third year and can be used now. This webinar is introducing new features which are currently available with the exception of the access to all reports which will be available in March 2020.
When you upload your data into the HIVQM Module, will you be able to see your data to make sure it's correct?	You will be able to see all the imported data in the Performance Measure page where you can check the accuracy of your data.

For the March period, when you will be able to access pass report, will you be able to delete a report that's already been posted and just upload a new one?	You will not be able to delete a report and upload a new one. You will only be able to edit a report or upload a new report.
For the comparison reports, will you know how many recipients have entered data for the performance measure you are looking at? Is there an "N"?	Currently, there is no "n" and you will not be able to see how many recipients entered data for performance measures.
Is it only ELIGIBLE clients that can be included?	You can enter clients who have received HIV services, regardless of funding source.
